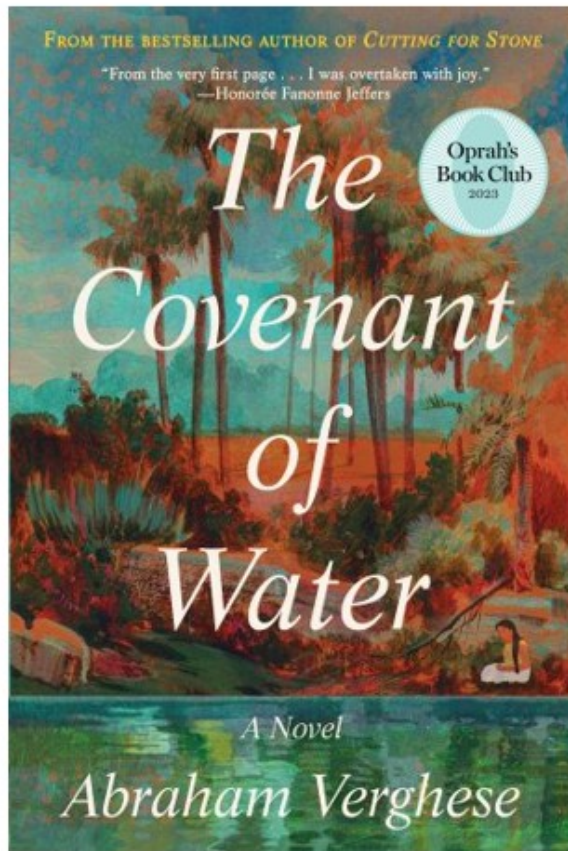
Food Drive for Nourishing Hope

3750 BOOK CLUB MEETING FOR NOVEMBER



Spanning the years 1900 to 1977, the book is set in Kerala, on India's Malabar Coast, and follows three generations of a family, that suffers from a peculiar affliction: in every generation, at least one person dies by drowning—and in Kerala, water is everywhere. At the turn of the century, a twelve-year old girl from Kerala's long-existing Christian community, grieving the death of her father, is sent by boat to her wedding where she will meet her forty-year old husband for the first time. From this unforgettable new beginning the young girl—and future matriarch—will witness unthinkable changes over the span of her extraordinary life, full of joy and triumph as well as hardship and loss, her faith and love the only constraints.

A shimmering evocation of a bygone India and of the passage of time itself, *The Covenant of Water* is a hymn to progress in medicine and to human understanding, and a humbling testament to the difficulties undergone by past generations for the sake of those alive today. It is one of the most masterful literary novels published in recent years. (An Oprah's Book Club Pick, Instant *New York Times* bestseller.)

This month's recipe

Melted Tomatoes on Fish

Broiling fresh tomato slices concentrates their umami and their sweetness. This recipe offers a simple, flavorful topping for delicate white fish:

20 minutes. Serves 4

1 large tomato, sliced
1 T extra virgin olive oil
4, 6 oz fillets of white fish (tilapia, haddock or hake)
2 T mayonnaise
½ t of Old Bay seasoning (or seafood seasoning alternative)
1/8 t freshly ground black pepper
1 lemon, cut into wedges

1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees. On a large foil-lined baking pan, place the tomato slices in a single layer. Drizzle with the oil
2. Blot the fish dry with a paper towel and place the fillets on the baking pan with the tomatoes. In a small bowl, mix the mayo with the Old Bay and pepper. Spoon the mixture over the fish
3. Switch the over to broil. Place the pan 6-8 inches under the broiler and broil until the tomatoes are bubbling hot and the fish flakes easily-- 5-8 minutes
4. Top the fish with the tomatoes and serve with lemon wedges
